Last year the Pharmaceutical Society of Northern Ireland held a Calculation Training Course for Pre-registration Trainees. The feedback from the course was very positive and as a result we are offering the Calculation Training Course again this year.

The course covers a broad range of pharmaceutical calculations and help will be available from both the course facilitators during the sessions. The course comprises of two sessions with attendance at both required. It is necessary to achieve at least 80% in the calculation section of the Registration Examination in order to pass the examination.
