The Standards for Pre-Registration Training

The Standards for Pre-Registration Training make it explicitly clear what the minimum requirements are for training to be recognised by the Pharmaceutical Society NI. The Standards apply to trainees, tutors and the respective employing organisations. Before embarking on a pre-registration training agreement, trainees, tutors and employers must read and understand what their obligations are in relation to the Standards for Pre-Registration Training.

If you have concerns that your training may not be in accordance with the Standards for Pre-Registration training then you should speak with your tutor or your employer in the first instance to resolve any issues. If the situation is not resolved, you can raise concerns about your training arrangements via the Pharmaceutical Society NI website or with the Pre-registration Lead directly. All concerns will be addressed and objectively investigated.
