

Dear Pre-registration student

As you have been informed, **13th April** is the closing date for completion of all of the mandatory distance learning courses associated with your Pre-registration training year. On reviewing completion, there are still some students who have yet to complete a number of courses.

In relation to the mandatory DL courses, completion numbers are as follows:

High risk medicines – 165 /169 completed

Medical calculations – 162 / 169 completed

Medication incidents – 163 / 169 completed

Minor ailments (all 7 sections) – 6 /169 completed.

If you have completed all aspects of the mandatory programme, then you have no further action to take. However, those who have still to complete some of the mandatory aspects of the programme, need to take immediate action as the portal for entering MCQ responses will close at midnight on 13th April. For those who still need to complete some of the mandatory DL courses, I would advise you to leave yourself sufficient time to study the material before attempting the MCQs. Please note that you are allowed a maximum of two attempts to achieve the 70% pass rate associated with each mandatory DL course.
