I have reviewed your progress with the NICPLD mandatory aspects of your Pre-reg training and wish to remind you of your deadlines and your responsibilities.

In relation to the *live workshops*, TWO students have still to register to attend the Law and Ethics workshops whilst FOUR students still need to register for Basic and Emergency First Aid. There are limited opportunities still available to attend these workshops so please, if you are one of these individuals, log onto the NICPLD website and register ASAP.

In relation to the *distance learning courses*, everyone has completed Controlled drugs – striking a balance and Responsible Pharmacist online courses. We recommended that Patient Medication Review and Records was completed by 25th November - 19 individuals have still to complete this online course.
