

Who can certify a degree certificate and the requirements.

The counter signatory must be a professional person of some standing in the community.

Examples of such a person might be: a solicitor, pharmacist, medical doctor or a licensed practitioner.

The person signing must not be related to you by birth or marriage. They should not be living at the same address or be in a personal relationship with you.

- They must have known you for at least 2 years
- They must certify on the reverse side the following handwritten declaration '***I certify that this is a true copy of <insert trainee's name> degree certificate***', it must also be signed and dated by the appropriate official.
- They must detail in capital letters their First Name(s), Surname, full address, profession & professional registration number (if applicable)(professional stamp if applicable).

The copy can be in black and white.
