

REGISTRATION WITH ANOTHER REGULATORY BODY

Those trainees planning to register with another regulatory body once registered as a pharmacist with the Pharmaceutical Society NI, will be required to apply for a Certificate of Current Professional Status (CCPS).

A CCPS can only be provided from the day you have been registered. Please ensure to submit your application before 5pm on the day of the deadline.

In order to register with another regulatory body at the end of the pre-registration year you must initially register with the Pharmaceutical Society NI. If you do not, you will not meet the requirements for EEA recognition of professional qualifications.

This is detailed in the Directive 2005/36/EC of the European Parliament and of the Council of 7 September 2005 on the recognition of professional qualifications.

THE CERTIFICATE WILL BE POSTED DIRECTLY TO THE EXTERNAL REGULATORY BODY AND NOT TO THE REGISTRANT.

Trainees can forward the completed documentation to the Pharmaceutical Society NI before they register as a pharmacist, however this will be held by the registration department and will NOT be completed until you are a registered pharmacist.
