

What to do if you fail the Registration Examination

If you fail the Registration Examination, you should contact the Pre-registration Lead as soon as possible who will discuss next steps and provide you with feedback. The process for appeals following failure to pass the examination is detailed further in section 10.13 in chapter 10 of the Pre-registration Training Manual.
